

Baggage allowance

Carry-on baggage

On flights operated by Air Canada, Air Canada Rouge or Air Canada Express, you may carry the following items with you in the cabin:

Standard article (not permitted)

Economy Basic: For tickets issued on or after January 3rd, 2025, on flights within North America and to sun destinations, Basic fares allow for **only a personal item on board**. Any additional bags will need to be checked in for a fee at the airport.

Personal article (permitted)

Maximum dimensions: 43cm x 33cm x 16cm (17in x 13in x 6in)

Your personal item must fit under the seat in front of you.

Checked baggage
